Digita Virtual Office overview



Provides remote access 24/7 to Digita software solutions and work emails by integrating with your existing email server (i.e. Office 365).



Digita applications are hosted on highly secure, UK-based servers in Amazon® Web Services (AWS) in a multi-tenant environment.



Automatic data replication between geographically separate AWS sites to facilitate disaster recovery and business continuity using AWS failover technology.



Utilises high-availability SQL clusters that can fail over between the physical datacentres.



Includes Microsoft Office Standard Suite (excluding Microsoft Exchange) for all users.



All software updates and upgrades to the Digita suite are deployed centrally for you by Thomson Reuters, outside of office hours, significantly reducing administration overheads and IT costs.



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SQL database backups are taken on a daily basis, with monthly and annual backups also being taken and stored for up to 12 months.



Optional multi-factor authentication (MFA) to provide secure user access to the DVO solution.



Minimal client hardware specifications are required to access the system (broadband internet connection is required).



The technology hosting the Digita applications is maintained and updated for customers behind the scenes, and the system has virtually unlimited scalability and can be quickly flexed according to demand.



All networking and server security is fully managed by Thomson Reuters.



The system is monitored 24/7 for security and server availability, with a global network of staff working to maintain availability.
